LGV/PCV Drivers CPC 'Periodic Training'

What is Periodic Training?

Driver Certificate of Professional Competence (CPC) training is continuing professional development which carries on throughout the drivers' career. Drivers will have to complete a minimum of 35 hours of approved training every five years.

If a driver holds both a Passenger Carrying Vehicles (PCV) and/or a Large Goods Vehicle (LGV) licence, they will only be required to complete one set of periodic training.

New drivers must complete their first cycle of periodic training within five years of the date they acquired their driver CPC.

Existing drivers (from September 10th 2009) have until September 2014 to complete the five days training which can be for example: one day a year over five years, or a five day block course during that period.

It is important that drivers allow themselves enough time to complete the training within the five year period; otherwise they will not be allowed to drive professionally until they do.

Therefore the sooner they train the sooner the knowledge and skills gained will enhance their continued professionalism.

Please note - only approved courses taken with approved training centres will count towards your periodic training.
